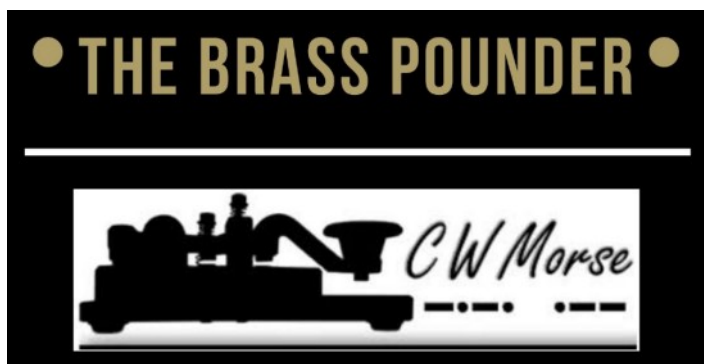




June 2025

The access to the Evaluator is via the OPEN View dialogue.

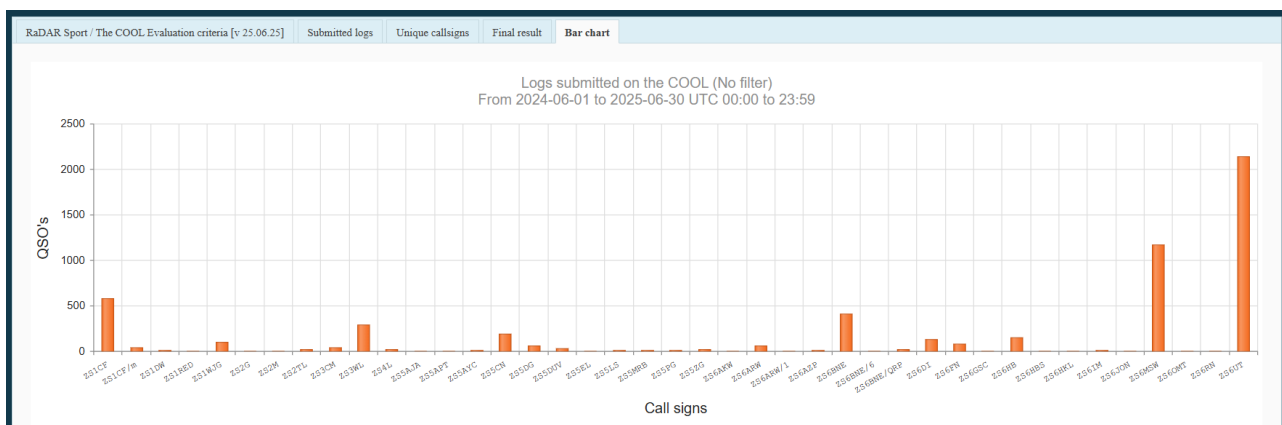

SUPER COOL Evaluator	These are QSO's that have been checked for log AND exchange accuracy.	Submit

The COOL Sprint (SSB / CW)	These are QSO's that have been evaluated for log and exchange accuracy x mode multipliers.	Submit
