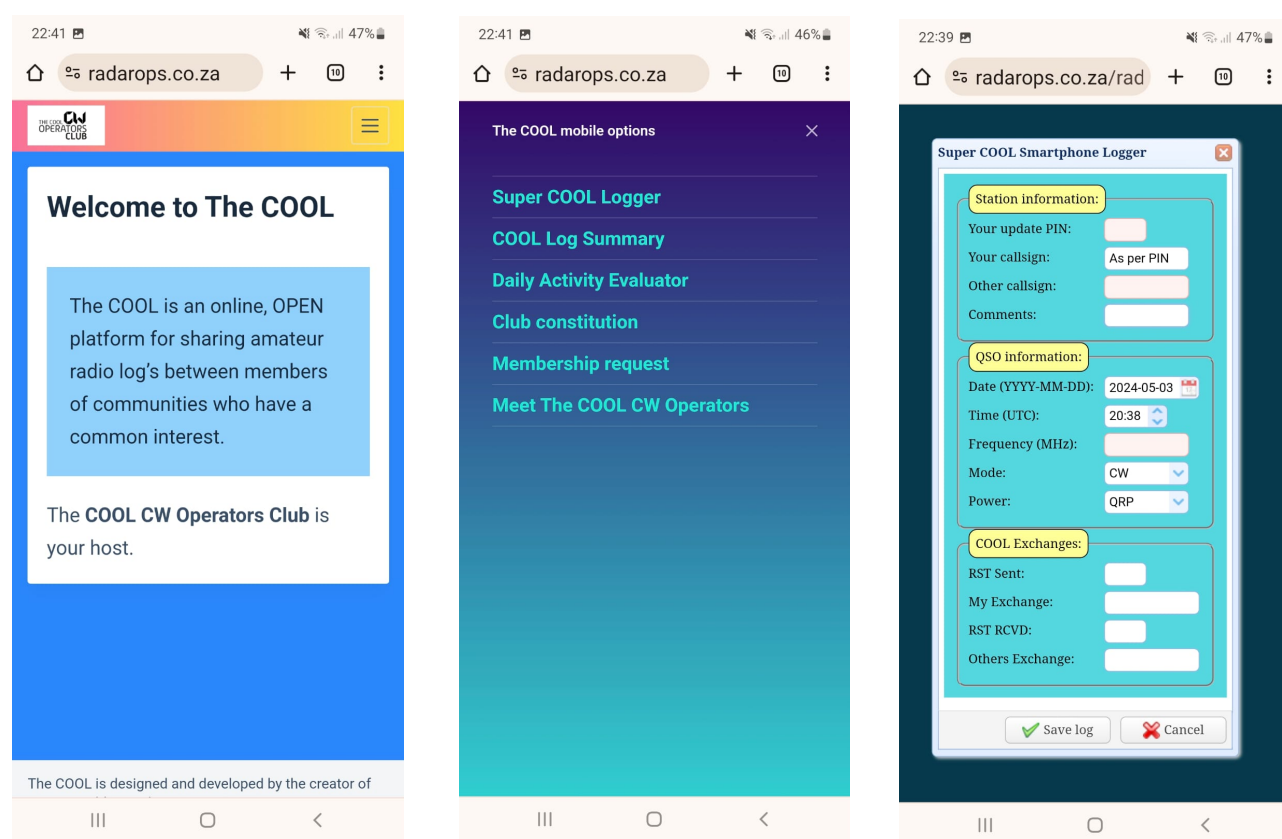


Newsletter - May 2024

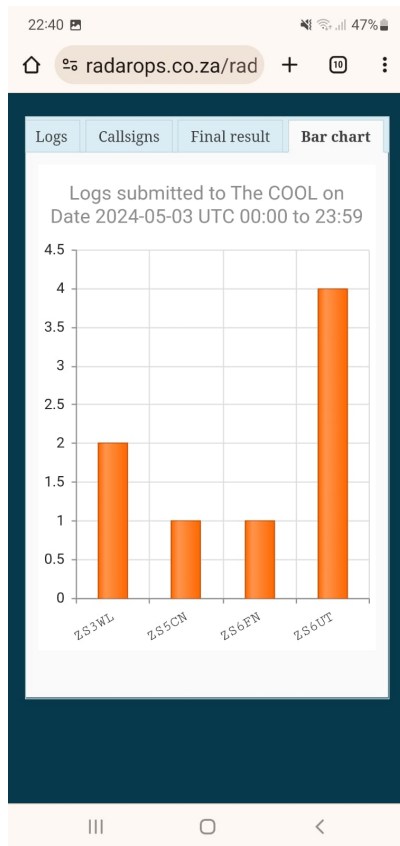

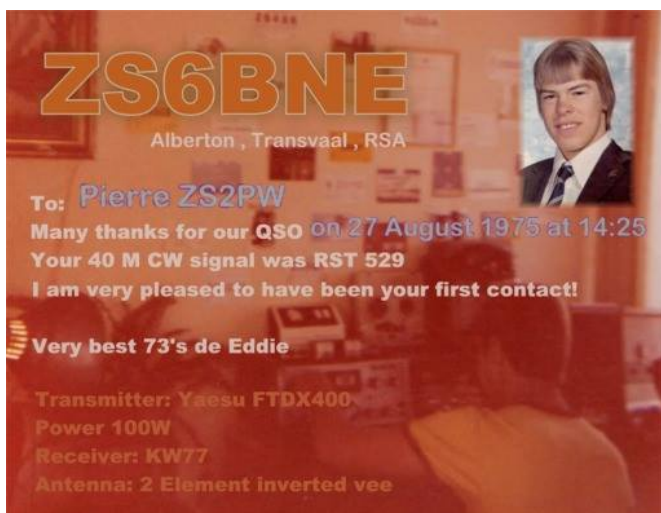
