

## Newsletter - May 2024



Smartphone access to The COOL has been updated to a more user friendly system although the real power of The COOL lies at the desktop access level.









An easy, user friendly way to simply log your QSO to share with other members of your community. A final gesture from both stations that enjoyed communicating with each other.


